Clayfield Outside School Hours Care offers a very exciting program during each holiday period. Children, Prep and above from any school are welcome to join us on a regular basis. To make a booking please read through the following program thoroughly and return the completed booking form with full payment.

Days of Opening – Monday 19th September 2011 – Friday 30th September 2011
Hours 6.30am -6.30pm (On Excursion Days {Wednesday} children must be at Vacation Care by 9am. We aim to be back by 3.00pm)

Bookings – All children **MUST** be pre-booked to attend any part of the program and all bookings are to be paid in full before children attend. There is a 2 week notice cancellation policy so all bookings must be paid for. To secure your bookings please ensure enrolment form and full payment are returned to OSHC by **Wednesday 14th September 2011.**

PHONE BOOKINGS will only be confirmed on receipt of the **OFFICIAL BOOKING FORM** and **FULL PAYMENT RECEIVED**

Things to Bring –

- Clayfield Outside School Hours Care supports healthy eating. Please support us by making healthy choices when packing your child's lunch. We provide morning tea and afternoon tea as well as cold water. **Please ensure your child has enough food and drinks for lunch. A fee of \$5 will be charged to your account if OSHC has to provide lunch for your child**
- All children must provide sunscreen and bring a hat to OSHC EVERYDAY, Otherwise **NO HAT SHADE PLAY!**
- Sensible clothing and shoes are required (closed in shoes or sandals). **NOT** thongs or slides
- Soft Drinks and food that needs heating in the microwave including 2Minute Noodles **MUST NOT** be bought to OSHC.
- Children are not permitted to bring any electronic games to OSHC including Playstation Portables, Nintendos or I-pods.

OSHC will not be offering walkover to extra curricular activities due to staffing

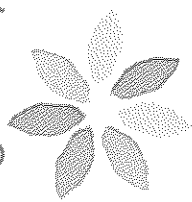
